You will select the appropriate age category for the patient for charting purposes.</p>

Pediatric assessment categories will address your assessments of Family, Environment, General health status, Patterns and finally Developmental Stages.

Troubleshooting Tips:

- *I have signed onto my pediatric visit and cannot find a pain assessment category in the PEDS section. Am I in the wrong assessment?*
No, the pain assessment is a 'shared' charting category and is found at the beginning of the Today's Care charting screens.
- *I am creating a NEW visit for my pediatric patient. However, I only have a selection for Today's Care or OASIS Assessment. There is no Peds assessment. What am I doing wrong?*
You are not doing anything incorrectly. You need to select Today's Care as your charting selection. Once in these screens, you will find PEDS as a category heading at the bottom of your left hand margin.
